Now it just so happens that according to my calculations that Omaha and Lincoln get \$8,668,250; that is 8½ million roughly and the rest of the state gets the rest. Now, a little item of important information which I know that all of you are going to enjoy. It has been said that the Legislature has decided to do this so we ought to do it. Well I will tell you who decided to do it the 8 or 9 Senators that introduced these amendments. Now wouldn't you know that the amendments that got the largest votes on this spending spree that we went on Tuesday was the improvement to the UNO athletic field and I want to compliment my friend, although he doesn't look like it now, Senator Snyder. He got the magnificent total on his amendment to spend a mere \$274,000 of 26 votes. 9 voting against and 14 not voting. Now lets go on down the line. Here is a little item of \$2,294,000 by Senator Luedtke, the diagnostic center. How many votes? For, 19; 6 against and 24 not voting. Is this an expression of the majority of the legislature when we have 49 members? Now here is Senator Luedtke's next little amendment. This is only \$5,610,000. He got the magnificent number of 16 votes on that amendment 10 voting against, and 23 not voting. Now Senator Mahoney did very well, he is next in line to Senator Luedtke. Senator Mahoney on his little item of \$4,900,000 got 20 votes. That shows something. Six voting against and 23 not voting. Now here is a nice little item that I am sure that everybody will be interested throughout the state. This is my friend Senator Burbach's motion to spend another \$867,300. Nobody will ever know how many votes he got on that because it was a voice vote. It could have been 2 for and 1 against. We don't know. Now Senator DeCamp on his Neligh mill, he got 16 votes. That was for \$25,000. Senator Stull, he didn't do too good, for a hundred thousand dollars for Ft. Robinson, he got 12 votes. Senator Carpenter for Lake Minatre got 12 votes and then he got 14 for another \$880,000. Senator Waldron is to be congratulated because he got 18 votes. Now the people in this state if they don't know that they should understand that there are 49 members of this legislature and that we are spending millions of dollars except on one item for a vote of less than the majority of our members. Senator Chambers took \$278,000 with having 13 votes, and 32 not voting. Now if that is the way, if that is the way we should be spending money down here if you think that the people agree with it, then I know how you are going to vote you are going to vote red on my motion and more power to you because I am voting for my own motion to return this bill and to strike the spending of \$15,000,000 over 15 million dollars.
