

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB533.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB533. All those in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Read

PRESIDENT: Senator Clark, are you in the chamber? Senator Clark. Stand by he is coming. Senator Clark we have you amendment to 533 on Select File.

SENATOR CLARK: I move the amendment be adopted. All this is is a corrective amendment for the one that I put on the other day, but it didn't take in all of the school districts, it a...this just takes in the elementary as well. I move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Question is shall the Clark amendment be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted?

CLERK: Read amendment.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Did the Senator explain what it did, I was out of the room.

PRESIDENT: Senator Clark.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Am I out of order to ask him what....

PRESIDENT: No, that is alright, I don't mind.

SENATOR CLARK: What it does Senator Carpenter is that in the western technical college districts that puts the school district in their entirety into that district and not just half of them. These lap over into Cherry County a ways, and it puts those districts into the western district. Do you understand what I am talking about? This is an amendment prepared by Emory because the one that I put on the other day didn't take in the entire school district, all it took in was the highschools. It should have the elementary in it at the same time so that they don't have a split district.

SENATOR CARPENTER: That answers my question.

PRESIDENT: Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 Ayes, 0 Nays and the remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: Clark amendment to 533 is adopted.

CLERK: Read. He got excused for the rest of the day.

PRESIDENT: Well gentlemen we what is your pleasure regarding the bill here 533, he has been excused for the day and we can't lay these things over too much longer. We can't, Senator Fred Carstens has a motion on the bill.
