Secondly we are talking once again about family, not family planning but what do we call it, yeah for rural doctors. This item was never presented to us to my knowledge when the University had the whole afternoon to come in here and make its presentation. So when this came about, I don't know. The third item on drugs, I'm not familiar with. So as far, SENator Proud, as far as I am concerned, I'm going to vote against the motion. We have considered this people have been given the opportunity to come before the committee and I would assume before some of the rest of you and we have appropriated the money and we have given the money that the Governor has recommended and I think that is as far as we should go this time

PRESIDENT: Senator Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: Mr. President, I can envision if I vote no, which I am now going to vote on the recommendation of the Chairman of the Appropriations Committee. The dentist writing me saying that we need this money etc., etc., etc. We are either going to do things down here in some kind of logical progression or we are not. Now Senator Marvel has said that they considered part of this and the other part they didn't even discuss the matter with him and now Senator Schmit in good faith and all that pops up for another hundred thousand or so. I think that we have got to put a stop to this and take a look at these requests next session.
