SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this area of the dental school is a real problem in that not only this money but further money is going to be something in the next year or so that they have much salary that is now coming from federal grants and this grant will stop in another year because they can not meet the requirements to get the grant and another year we will probably be talking about somewhere between four and six hundred thousand dollars in salary for present staff that will have to be taken over from the state level. I think if there is anything that we could do now to ease it would probably be much better.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the amendment? Alright Senator Schmit, I guess that there really isn't much closing on the first section here as long as the question is divided but are we all through discussing this, Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the legislature I would just like to comment, make one more brief comment. We did adopt the Governor's budget, which is a little tighter in this area than our own, than the committees recommendations were, and so we are not entirely scot clean on this thing. I think that we need the money and I wish that you would support the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Question is shall the, question is shall that portion of the amendment be adopted, which has been discussed which relates to section 49, agency number 51-1 and program 711, be adopted. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no.
