

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, how many members are excused and how many are just wandering around?

CLERK: We have 5 excused and we have at least 3 wandering yet.

PRESIDENT: We are under a call of the....Senator Mahoney, take your seat please. We are under a call of the house and the question under vote....The question under vote is the divided Schmit amendment which relates to agency 51, the dental college program 711. Senator .....

CLERK: Senator Wiltse moves the call be raised.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to raise the call. All those in favor of raising the call vote aye, those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, and 1 nay to raise the call.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 12 nays

PRESIDENT: Several wandering. Alright the first half of the Schmit amendment is then adopted. We move the the second half of the Schmit amendment. That is up for debate now. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, after that experience I don't know if it pays to run with this one or not, but I'll try it. I think that it is still a good amendment. As I said before we spend a lot of money for the medical a schools. We train these young men and put them out into other states to take their residency and they never return to Nebraska. We invest \$50,000 to \$100,000 in them and we decide then that we are going to become penny wise and pound foolish so we hang on then to the \$13,000 that it takes for residency and they never return to Nebraska. I think that it is....I can't excuse what Senator Marvel refers to because I know that he is correct when he says that these people become a...a...come before the budget committee and they are not perhaps explicit as I understand the \$200,000 was the medical colleges fair share of the cut of the university took somewhere along the line. They have asked for me to introduce the bill and I have done so. Now in reference to the \$100,000 for the drug prevention program. You remember that we passed some bills that had to do with drug treatment. We passed some bills that gave money to the highway patrol to take care of the problem in the drug area. At that time there was some comment made that we didn't do anything to treat drug addiction. So I said that I would introduce an amendment to this bill which would provide some money for that program and that is what I am doing. NOW I am going to tell you one more thing and that is that in race horse fund, the pair mutual fund which was set up under 76 we are going to raise about a million dollars more revenue at least a million dollars more revenue annually than the revenue was anticipated. So, since we do have more than that one million dollars revenue I don't think that we are being fiscally irresponsible to come in and ask for this money at this time. We have only used about \$350,000 of that million and we still have got some in the cash register and I would appreciate your support of these two amendments and I ask for the question. I think that we have discussed it enough.
