That is not the correct statement and I'm sure that Senator Burbach will not object to my saying that because I'm sure he realizes that they still will pay a State Income tax. Gentlemen, this is not a case of payment or non payment of taxes, it is a case of an equity tax payment with other corporations and I thank you very much and I will close with that statement.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 7 nays for a call of the house.

PRESIDENT: We're under a call of the house. At the next bell please indicate your presence.

CLERK: Senator Snyder voting no on the original motion.

PRESIDENT: Senator Nore, did we get--did we get your vote?

CLERK: Senator Nore voting no on the original motion.

PRESIDENT: We're under call of the house. The question is the Duis amendment on 526 on select file. Senator Nore, we're under call of the house. Take your seat, please. Senator Stull. Wait a minute, Senator Kennedy voting no, on the Duis amendment to 526. Just a second. Senator Kennedy voting no.
