

to adopt the Warner amendment. Senator Waldron, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR WALDRON: I wanted to ask Senator Warner a question. It is his amendment and I wasn't here when the amendment was under debate...is Senator Barnett and I just wonder, what's the motion? The motion is to reconsider, right?

PRESIDENT: No. No reconsideration. The motion is to return 529 to Select File for a specific amendment, that is to adopt the Warner amendment. In essence, it is reconsideration, yes.

SENATOR WALDRON: He hasn't. He has already re...you can't ask a question.

PRESIDENT: Yes. Yes. Go ahead. Ask a question.

SENATOR WALDRON: Senator Warner, you said you wanted to set the rates for just this year and it would not be a continuing thing. Why do you believe that the Legislature should set the rates this year but should not continue to set the rates. I wouldn't be against them setting them this year if we would set them every year but I just can't understand just why the one time affair. I have always, and I will remind you back in 1967, I voted to have the Legislature...

PRESIDENT: Senator Carstens, we are under Call of the House. Would you take your seat please sir.

SENATOR WALDRON: ...set the rates at that time and have been for that proposal all along.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Waldron, the reason we made it for just this year is because the Legislature is the only one who could reduce the rates this year and this is the year that the revenue....

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter, we are under Call of the House.

SENATOR WARNER: ...is running a great deal higher than the estimates were. By reducing them this year, you proportionately return to each individual taxpayer the amount that he was overcollected and this is the reason for doing it this way.

PRESIDENT: The motion under vote is shall 529 be returned to Select File for specific amendment, that is, the Warner amendment. We have the Sergeant at Arms out looking for Senators. Motion is to raise the Call. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The clerk will record. All right. We are still under a Call of the House. Take your seats, gentlemen. Senator Keyes just went out. He can ask him to return. Now, Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: I request a Roll Call vote.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator. A Roll Call vote has been requested. Will the Sergeant at Arms get Senator Keyes who went out the south (inaudible).
