what we're trying to do is get fuel and I think probably that's why that wording.

SENATOR STAHMER: Well Senator Kennedy, again to try and make myself clear. In the past, for instance, some distributor might be selling to his own stations regularly 10% cheaper than he would be to independents. This would force him to sell at the same cost to everyone. I would just question whether we can do that. I would think if you put in here wording that says that the percentage of difference would not be any, could not be allowed to change from what it has been regularly in the past year or so, you'd be on much further--more legal footing than you are now.

SENATOR KENNEDY: I wouldn't object to that if you want to add that wording to it, but--

SENATOR STAHMER: I, I just think it would improve it.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Our problem here is trying to get it done in the time allowed.

SENATOR STAHMER: Well, I'd like unanimous consent if I could, just to try to work out something and give it to Senator Kennedy and bring this up as soon as possible.

PRESIDENT: That's fine, you can work out whatever you want. Senator Kennedy, what is your pleasure? If he, if he wants to propose something more to this, it will take another specific amendment and the only thing we can do with this bill right now is to return it for a specific amendment that, which is before the body. If you want to withdraw that amendment, reamend it or somehow or another, that's up to you, Senator Kennedy. What is your pleasure?

SENATOR KENNEDY: I would so move it at this time. I think we have a problem here that needs to be solved. I think that wording that's in there is sufficient according to the attorneys so I would move that, that, that we now vote on 587 as amended.

PRESIDENT: Alright, question is shall 587 be returned to select file for the specific am--the bill is returned. Alright, the question is shall we adopt the amendment then. All those in favor of adopting the specific amendment as explained by Senator Kennedy to 587, vote aye. All those opposed vote no. You're voting on the specific amendment to 587, on select file. Bill having been returned. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, no nays, 20 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes, I would ask for LB 587 as amended to be moved to E&R again.

PRESIDENT: Motion before us now is to readvance LB 587 as amended. All those in favor of the motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill as amended is readvanced. Attention please then the final reading of LB 579. Assistant Clerk will read the bill.

CLERK: Reads bill.
