CLERK: 31 ayes, no nays, remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: Motion prevails. Proceed to the final reading of LB 110. Assistant Clerk will read the bill. Blue copy.

CLERK: Reads bill.

LB 110

(End of Belt #17)

(Start Belt #18)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Voting on the final passage of LB 110 with the emergency clause. Once again, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Reads vote. 41 ayes, no nays, 8 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. Attention please, the final reading of LB 110A.

CLERK: Reads bill.

LB 110A.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Once again have you all voted? Once again the Chair would inquire, have you all voted? Senator Carstens, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR CARSTENS: Is everybody present and accounted for?

CLERK: No.

PRESIDENT: Have you all voted now? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Reads vote. 34 ayes, 6 nays, 9 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Bill is passed with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: Mr. President, some reports.

PRESIDENT: Read the reports.

CLERK: Reads reports.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature was in session and capable of transacting business I have signed LB 261, 134, 236, LB 400, 505, 534, 536, 589, 110 and 110A. Chair recognizes Senator Stahmer. For what purpose do you rise, Senator?

SENATOR STAMMER: Mr. President and Members of the body. I happened to have lunch this noon with Mr. Peters and he mentioned that he had heard from Mr. Graham that there is a possibility or that--they already have notification that there will be a \$3,000,000 cutoff of Federal funds on the retardation programs and I just--I thought there would perhaps be a letter here from the Governor, and I just asked Mr. Eldin Ehrlich to check with the Governor's office to see about verification of this and if this is
