

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner asking for a roll call vote.
Clerk will clear the board.

CLERK: (Roll Call vote taken)

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I change my vote from aye to nay for purposes of reconsideration.

CLERK: Senator Carpenter changing from aye to nay. 28 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. The next order of business that was the Chair's understanding is that there was a motion now by Senator Carpenter to suspend the rules and read the bills on final reading that are scheduled for today. Now is there need for further discussion of that motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next.....

PRESIDENT: The next motion was to suspend the rules and take up the bills on final reading. Thank you, that motion has been withdrawn, are there objections to the withdrawal of the suspension of the rules motion? Any objections, hearing none, so ordered. Then it is withdrawn. What do we have on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that LB256 be passed notwithstanding the objection of the Governor, signed Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: Motion now before us is relating to passage of LB256, notwithstanding the objection of the Governor. Senator Carpenter in the chamber? Senator Carpenter, do you want to take up your motion on LB256 to pass it notwithstanding the objection of the Governor? The Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Now Mr. President, I will be very brief, and very short. The body a couple of days ago, gave this measure 40 votes, 40 votes, 6 not voting and 3 not present, I think everybody understand what is in the bill, it would serve no good purpose for me to attempt to bore you in the area of reciting all of the things that you already know. So for the sake of brevity, I move the previous question, I have no closing, lets vote on it.

PRESIDENT: Previous question has been moved on the motion. Does the Chair see five hands? I see two hands, three hands, thank you. Question is shall the debate now close on the motion. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Motion is to close debate on the motion to override the Governor's veto on LB256. Have you all voted. Motion is to cease debate on the motion to override on LB256. Have you all voted. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays to cease debate.

PRESIDENT: Debate will now close. Senator Carpenter, do you have any closing?

SENATOR CARPENTER: No closing.

PRESIDENT: Alright the question is shall LB256 be passed notwithstanding the objection of the Governor. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Shall LB256 be passed notwithstanding the objection of the Governor? Once again,
