

June 1, 1973 NOON

(Start of Belt #14)

PRESIDENT: Will the Legislature please come to order. Roll Call. Please indicate your presence. Once again, have you all indicated your presence? The clerk will record.

CLERK: A quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Are there any notices of Committee Hearings or reports.

CLERK: None, Mr. President, Mr. President, I ask to be excused until I can return. Signed, Senator Kime.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kime asking to be excused until returning. Are there objections to his absence? Hearing none, so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to suspend the Rules and consider bracketed bills on Final Reading today, namely, 365 thru 587 excluding those with fiscal impact.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I think the motion is self-evident. I don't have anything further to say.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion. The question is shall the rules be suspended and Final Reading be taken up. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Motion is to suspend the Rules and take up the bills on Final Reading. Senator Snyder, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SNYDER: Just a question of the chair, Mr. President. How many reported in at Roll Call?

PRESIDENT: 26.

SENATOR SNYDER: It matters not to me, Mr. President, but it just seemed to me that we were missing a few of our colleagues. I think there are a couple of bills up there that are going to be...29 checked in the clerk says. I won't make a motion but it might be a consideration to recess for another five minutes or so until some of those who, apparently, are arriving late from lunch would get here.

PRESIDENT: Stand by. We have a motion we are voting on now. When that fails or whatever happens to it, why then we will fly from there. Motion is to suspend the Rules and take up Final Reading. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Please indicate your presence. Have you all voted? All right. The clerk will record. OK, the motion fails. Senator Snyder, you had a motion?

SENATOR SNYDER: Apparently have no choice. I would move for a five minute recess just to see if we can get another ten members or so back from lunch before we begin on Final Reading.
