PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Voting on the Final passage of LB 530. If you are going to vote, now is the time. Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: Vote read.

PRESIDENT: Senator Wiltse voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Wiltse voting aye. Reading of vote continued. 41 ayes, 0 nays, 8 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Attention please, the Final reading of 587.

CLERK: Final Reading. LB 587.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Voting on the Final passage of LB 587. Once again, the chair would inquire, have you all voted? Senator Carpenter, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Ask for a Roll Call vote.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter asking for a Roll Call vote. The clerk will clear the Board.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This, my friend, if you don't pass, you will rue the day you didn't.

PRESIDENT: Clear the Board. Senator Carpenter asking for a roll call vote. Roll Call vote has been called for.

CLERK: Roll Call vote taken. 30 ayes, 14 nays, 5 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill having failed to receive the constitutional majority, the question is shall the bill pass with the emergency clause stricken. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. The question is shall the bill pass with the emergency clause stricken. Your voting apparatus is malfunctioning. Senator Lewis voting aye. Once again, have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: Senator Frank Lewis voting aye. Vote read. 27 ayes, 14 nays, 8 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed with the emergency clause stricken.

CLERK: Mr. President, an Explanation of Vote. Read. Signed, Senator Waldron. Mr. President, I move we reconsider our action on LB 472. Signed, Senator Carpenter.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This has been discussed. I have nothing to say. I move for the previous question. Let's vote on it.

PRESIDENT: The previous question has been moved. Does the chair see five hands. The question is shall the debate now close on the motion to reconsider. All those in favor of closing debate will vote aye. All those opposed will vote no. Thank you. The clerk will record. I'm sorry.

CLERK: You had enough votes. You had 27 ayes.
