

SENATOR BARNETT: No, but just as soon as you are done with it.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? The question is then, shall LB 114 be read. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Senator Lewis voting aye. OK. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 1 nay, 10 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Very good. LB 114 will be read. Senator Barnett, for what purpose do you rise? Yes. The question is shall the Call be raised. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Lewis voting aye.

PRESIDENT: The clerk will record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, 12 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. Attention please. The Final Reading of LB 114. That still requires the Senators to be in their seats.

CLERK: Final Reading. LB 114.

PRESIDENT: (mike off) procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Voting on the Final passage of LB 114 with the emergency clause. Senator Frank Lewis voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Lewis voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Once again the chair would inquire, have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: Vote read. 44 ayes, 1 nay, 4 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. What other motion do we have on the desk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that we read LB 162 and 162A. Signed, Senator Luedtke.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Luedtke for his motion on 162 and 162A.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I make this motion on behalf of Senator Waldron who is not here. These are his bills. These are the Court Reporters bills. As Senator Waldron said before he left that there is great urgency that we do take them up because of the fact that as with all these others, if they do not go into effect this session why there will be no opportunity to pay the increase in salaries to the Court Reporters and the case was made on the floor. I don't think there is need for any further discussion, you are either for or against them. I just want them to come up for a vote.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall LB 162 and 162A be read. Is there any further discussion of the motion? All those in favor of reading the bills vote aye. All those opposed vote no. The motion is to read LB 162 and 162A on Final Reading. The motion is to read LB 162 and 162A and the chair would again have to inquire, have you all voted? OK. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 12 nays, 18 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Do we have other motions on the desk?
