PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. Chairman, I would have to be opposed to the amendment and the amendment to the amendment. I think that we learn by repetitious a...a..repetition and I think I would like to see these publications left as they are. When it comes to government sometimes we let the dollars roll by trying to save pennies.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the amendment to the amendment? Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: I move for the adoption of the amendment to the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: May I ask Senator Richendifer a question please?

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Yield.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Well what it says then in all newspapers of general circulation in the county. Now would the World Herald be circulated in my county? I think that it is. The Lincoln Journal is circulated in my county. I am questioning whether or not you want that there as stated? If you want to have the amendment such that those newspapers that originate in the county that have their headquarters and the publishing headquarters in the county maybe that might go. But I think that it is ...the amendment is not just exactly what you want.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: I think that probably there is another law that pertains to this Senator Whitney, I can't tell you off the top of my head what it is, but this is controlled and they have to prove up that they are a newspaper of general circulation in the county before they can even participate in the advertising to the village boards or the county. I don't whether or not it would be one or all I really can't see where it would make a difference. I don't believe that the World Herald would even take it.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, I'm not certain just what this amendment would do, and I prefer that it be held over to Select File and go ahead and put it through as it now is. If you do not care to hold it over to Select File, I'd have to vote against it even though I may be in favor of it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Anderson.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Mr. President, members of the legislature I would just like to say that I have basically the same reservations about this amendment to the amendment as does Senator Whitney. I think that there are other laws which effect the selection of a legal newspaper for county purposes and I am wondering if any of these would be affected. I am wondering if some of these questions should not be checked out before this particular amendment is considered. I am wondering if this could be withdrawn and withheld for Select File and we could go back to the original Richendifer amendment.
