Now I don't know how long that would take but as far as our committee we would be ready to hear it as soon as the amendments and things were printed. It is quite extensive and our committee...and I'm getting some amendments drawn up for our committee right now but we will be prepared whenever we think that we can get the material to the public and maybe you can tell us, may we have that bill printed with the amendments again?

SENATOR KENNEDY: Not as a committee but the agreement of quite a few organizations and so forth have been working have come up with amendments and they are printed but it is not printed as a bill and I think that we ought to give the public the opportunity to look at it as a bill, rewritten. Now if that can be done that would be my request as chairman of the public health and welfare.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I would like to amend the Senator's motion to direct the Clerk to reprint the bill with the all the known amendments asserted in the bill. If that is too big, it would probably be better to just print a new bill and have Mr. Burnett insert the amendments as if it were a new bill. That is what it is going to be anyway.

CLERK: Are there other amendments than what I have then?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Not that I know of.

CLERK: I have amendments from the committee, I have two pages of amendments offered by Senator Moylan.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL. I gave Senator Kennedy the latest draft that I have which is dated about the 18th of December from the head of the department of institutions, and I don't think Mr. Clerk that you have those amendments so I think that those amendments should go with the other proposed amendments and have it all printed.
