

federal trade commission had no right, or no power to enact such rules and regulations such as this one and others that they proposed in the consumer field. Since that has been resolved now, this rule and regulation will go back into effect this year under the federal rule. The primary opposition to the old bill that it did not conform with the federal trade commission bill. Now the people and some of them worry about effecting specific sales practices like the Avon products that would give certain things away without anticipating anything in return where other people give things away and with anticipating that this will actually bring them business. We tried to differentiate between these two types of practices. We took by doing this we took away the opposition of the Avon people. The only people now that I recall as I can recall are the door to door cookware salesmen and primarily it was the Vitacraft corporation. I don't know why they were opposed that but they thought that it interfered with their right to make sales in the home.

SENATOR KELLY: This long list of opposition in committee hearing was based on administrative problems rather than content problems, is that correct?

SENATOR WALDRON: Primarily, Senator, of course you notice that some of them on there, we exempted in Nebraska New Car Dealers Association from the list, the bankers are not included in here anymore whatsoever, and so I see that the Kirby vacuum Company appeared against now they might still have some objections, the Kirby people, because I have not been in close contact with them recently but this Mr. Johnson from the Vitacraft still objects but by and large all of the other people are satisfied.

SENATOR KELLY: Thank you very much Senator.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the bill? Senator Waldron do you have any closing on the bill? The question is then shall LB212 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Voting on the advancement of 212, from General File. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 Ayes, 0 nays and 23 not voting Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced. Senator Keyes in the chamber yet? Senator Luedtke can we move to your LB520 then? Very good. We will take up General File debate on LB520 Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: Read LB520.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President I move for the adoption of the committee amendments. Mr. President, members of the legislature LB520 is actually a bill which would allow a person to deposit his drivers license with an officer, a law enforcement officer upon being stopped for certain offenses and arrested for certain offenses with the assurance that he would appear in court. It is a citation type law which says that he is cited and the rules of the court concerning citation
