SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the legislature I have asked the agency which is affected by LB77 and 77a to make a recommendation to me as to whether or not they need these bills in the present form at this time and they have promised me that within a few days they would have a recommendation. I have also asked for a clarification from the department of environmental control on 254a because isn't an appropriation bill and it was my understanding that because it was not read at the last session that we might not need this bill at this time. So I would like to move to bracket those three bills at this time. Until I get word from the agencies. I was

PRESIDENT: I was momentarily distracted. What three bills?

SENATOR SCHMIT: 77, 77a and 254a.

PRESIDENT: They are not expected at all?

SENATOR SYAS: I don't know if they are or not.

PRESIDENT: We will take Final Reading, first I think before we go to that. Maybe they will get here by then Senator Syas, then stand by. Senator Snyder, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, I would ask that LB94 be bracketed on Final READING.

PRESIDENT: Senator Snyder asking unanimous consent to bracket 94 on Final Reading, have you heard the motion? Are there any objections to bracketing 94? Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: I would ask unanimous consent to have 43 and 43a bracketed until Thursday morning.

PRESIDENT: 43 and 43a?

SENATOR STULL: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Stand by, I've got to dispose of Senator Snyder's motion first. Are there objections to bracketing LB94? On Final reading. Hearing none, so ordered. Senator Stull has made the request that 43 and 43a be bracketed on Final Reading, are there objections? Senator Marvel are you objecting to bracketing those two bills? If you are not stand by for just a moment.

SENATOR MARVEL: I have a general motion to take care a of all of these motions that have been made so far. So... Vince do you have the form up there?

CLERK: I have a motion on 43a. I need some amendments.
