PRESIDENT: Have you all voted. Clerk will record.
I'm sorry Senator Fellman.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 4 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. I didn't quite catch
you out of the corner of my eye.

CLERK: Mr. President unanimous consent to unbracket LB490
on General File (Signed) Senator Kremer.

PRESIDENT: LB 490. Are there objections to unbracketing
LB 490 on General File. Senator Whitney, for what purpose
do you rise?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, this means that this bill'
then would follow in General File, rather than being taken
up again immediately. Because LB 432 is a bill which is
a bill which has been ready now for several days. And I'd
like to take it up. So I have no objection if it follows
432.

PRESIDENT: ALL right. Stand by for just a minute.
All right. In order to bring this back on the agenda, and'
the order of things, Senator Whitney. We'll unbracket 490.
And I agree with you that it should follow in the order
of General File up here. It is already debated on General
File LR 8, we're ready now for LR 19. That would be the
next order. Then it's the chairs understanding that the
fiscal note is missing on 502, so we can't take up 502 on
General File. Next would be Senator Whitneys 432. At this
time lets see what test the water here on Legislative
Resolution 19. We're on Legislative Resolution 19

PRESIDENT: And move this on to the General File consideration
of LB 432. Senator Whitney it is my understanding that you..
It is my understand that Senator Whitney says there is no
fiscal note yet on 502. Is that correct, sir? All right,
no fiscal note, we can't take it up. Move to 432. Senator
Atahmer your light is still on. I'd appreciate. Ready for
the General File debate of LB 432.

CLERK: read LB 432. Mr. President the Education Committee
indefinitely postponed the bill. It was then placed on
General File and now it's pending the action of the committee.
There are now amendments pending by Senator Syas. Which
were printed in last years Journal

PRESIDENT: Stand by. Senator Syas we're ready for your
amendments here on LB 432.

SENATOR SYAS: I've got an amendment of 432?

CLERK: Read amendments to 432.

SENATOR SYAS: Well, for the time being I will withdraw
my amendment. And I might have put it out to Advanced
Select File, I don't remember if I've got it. Now six or
nine months later.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas is asking unanimous consent to
withdraw his amendment. Are there objections to the with-
drawal of that amendment. Hearing none. So ordered the
amendment is withdrawn. Are there any amendments to the
bill.

CLERK: There are then some amendments offered by Senator
Whitney.

PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney we are ready for you to take
up the amendments to the bill.
