SENATOR STAHMER: I pushed the light and it didn't register.

PRESIDENT: Fine, thank you. We'll record that as voting aye.

CLERK: 3 ayes, 30 nays and 16 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion is lost. Still have before the body LR19. The motion is to advance the bill, we have already adopted Senator Carpenter's amendment. The question is shall LR19 be advanced from general file to E & R Initial: Senator Stahmer?

SENATOR STAHMER: I ask for a record vote.

PRESIDENT: Very good. The question is shall LB19 be advanced from General File to E. & R initial, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The motion is to advance LR 19. Have you all voted? The motion is to advance LR19 from General File. Now have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Voting aye Senator Burbach, Carpenter, C. Carsten, Clark Dickinson, Goodrich, Hasebroock, Johnson, Kennedy, Kime, F. Lewis, R. Lewis, Mahoney, Maresh, Marvel, Moylan, Murphy, Proud, Rasmussen, Savage, Skarda, Snyder, Stromer, Syas, Waldron, Whitney and Wiltse. Voting nay, Senators Anderson, Barnett, Chambers, DeCamp, Duis, Epke, Fellman, Fowler, Keyes, Luedtke, Marsh, Schmit, Simpson, Stahmer, Warner. Not voting Senator F. Carstens, Cavanaugh, Kelly, Kremer, Nore, Richendifer and Stull. 27 ayes, 15 nays 5 not voting.

PRESIDENT: That is alright, the bill is advanced. Senator Nore, the Chair is sorry but the rules say that I can't take call in votes so forth on that you have to be here to punch the button, and that is it.

CLERK: Mr. President, unanimous consent to unbracket LB66. Not to take it up just unbracket it. Signed Senator Barnett.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to unbracket LB66, are there objections? We are not taking it up, it is just to unbracket it. Are there any objections? Hearing none, so ordered. 66 is unbracketed.

CLERK: Mr. President, unanimous consent to unbracket LB359, signed Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: The same unanimous consent to unbracket 359, are there objections to unbracketing the bill? Hearing none, so ordered.

CLERK: We have got a bunch of new bills.

PRESIDENT: Read the titles. Wait just a minute, the Chair recognizes Senator Snyder, he had a point of personal privilege. Senator Snyder.

SENATOR SNYDER: Thank you Mr. President. A question of Speaker Proud if he would please?

PRESIDENT: Speaker Proud, will you yield to a question?

SENATOR SNYDER: Senator, I am at my limit for introduction of bills, I was wondering, I have got one drawn up to have class 3 districts, school boards run by districts, since you have one in your district, would you be so proud as to introduce it for me?
