PRESIDENT: Bill is returned. Now is there any further discussion of the amendment to the bill? Senator Carpenter back to you.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This amendment as I...also endorses and accepted by Mr. Sullivan who is the head of the Motor Vehicle Department. I am sure that the amendment is alright. I move for its adoption. Has it been adopted?

PRESIDENT: We have the bill back, now we have to adopt the amendments.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move for the adoption of the amendments.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the amendments to the bill, question is shall the amendments as explained by Senator Carpenter to LB590 on Select File be adopted. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are voting on the adoption of the amendment on 590 on Select File as explained by Senator Carpenter. The Chair is not in a position to lobby for votes but it does take 25 in order for you to adopt an amendment to a bill as proposed a specific amendment on Select File. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion is adopted. Senator Carpenter what is your pleasure regarding the bill, we have adopted the amendment.

SENATOR CARPENTER: (machine not activated) E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to advance LB590 from Select File to E & R for engrossing. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered the bill as amended is advanced. Do you have other motions on the desk?

CLERK: Read notices. Read Duis motion.

PRESIDENT: Is Senator Duis in the chamber? Senator Duis we are ready for your motion here. Chair recognizes Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: I move the motion. The a...a..this motion I got together with Senator Carpenter and Senator Chambers and I also got ahold of Mr. Burnett down at the office where he is and checked with him to be sure that the Attorney General had the perfect right to go directly to the Supreme Court in this case and he assures me that it is possible. I also asked him to draft this motion so that it would be correct in detail as far as I could understand. I sincerely hope that we pass this motion and I am certainly open to any suggestion of any other member of the legislature that might improve it.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion of the motion? Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: As you recall yesterday we had a discussion on the problem that is going to confront, particularly those people who aspire to the Governor or Lt. Governor of this state. This amendment was brought about by Senator Duis and others making a study to the extent that they did, in order to bring into prospect and position of doing the right thing. I have
