PRESIDENT: Senator Mahoney for what purpose do you wish to rise.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President the clerk has a motion on his desk.

CLERK: Yes I also have Resolution 103, Mr. President which will be inserted in the Journal.
Mr. President, I move that we request the Governor that he return LB 280 for further consideration. Signed Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President we did discuss this and then we went on to other business. I did not have the opportunity to answer Senator Marvel in the fact that we were so unique and different that we are unicameral that we should not have another opportunity to look at this. This is a bill that came across in the very early days and we quickly addressed ourselves to looking it over and passing it because it didn't seem to be any particular group that had given it any great thought since the recess the interim period and I'm sure that there other Senators in here that can look at this bill and see that we have as I have said in my earlier statement and giving my earlier talk by giving away some of the rights that this Legislature should have. And so I want to repeat that because its most important that we as Legislators look at this bill and see that the very thing that we holler about and raise the most cain that the federal government and all the other governmental bodies reduce us down to practically where we have no powers. We are assisting in helping this effort by passing this type of legislation. So I ask that this particular bill be brought back from the Governors office that we do look at it and have an amendment prepared to see that we rightly so as the other 47 states as they pass penal bills, as they pass all of the other legislation that brings us into the modern times, but this Legislature of Nebraska surely not do a job of reversing itself and be going 100% different direction.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Marvel. The motion is to return LB280 to the Governors office.

SENATOR MARVEL: I wish to respectfully object to bringing the bill back. This bill has received considerable study. It was the subject of a subcommittee meeting, not this year but the previous year. Those who object to this had adequate time to raise objection. I recognize the fact that this bill is one that was held over. This subject has been rather thoroughly discussed in my opinion the Legislature is not giving up any of its perogatives. It is simply making use of the tools that are available if after this has been explored, this does seem adequate because of the flexibility involved in the one house legislature there is ample opportunity to change. Therefore I think we should try. This is not a hurried attempt at all. We studies this rather thoroughly, and therefore I object to bringing the bill back.
