PRESIDENT: Stand by, were checking to see if some bills went down to some committees and we don't know the exact disposition of those. Be at ease for just a little bit. Alright is there any other business to come before the body?

CLERK: Read adjournment-

PRESIDENT: There is a motion to adjourn until Thursday 9:00 a.m. All those in favor of adjournment until 9:00 a.m. Thursday, say aye, those opposed say no. Alright, the motion is to adjourn until 9:00 Thursday all those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. The motion is for 9:00, if you don't want to support 9:00 vote no. Motion is to adjourn until 9:00 Thursday. If you want a different time we have to have another motion. Motion is to adjourn until 9:00 Thursday. Once again have you all voted? Motion is to adjourn until 9:00 Thursday, once again the Chair is asking have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 15 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion is lost. Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. Chairman I move that we adjourn until 10:00 a.m. Thursday.

PRESIDENT: Motion is now to adjourn until 10:00 Thursday. All those in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say no. Ayes have it so ordered. We are adjourned until 10:00 Thursday.
