PRESIDENT: Senator Luedtke is asking unanimous consent to bracket LB 568 until Tuesday. Are there objections to bracketing the bill. Hearing none so ordered then. We will bracket the bill until Tuesday. That brings up LB 92. Senator Snyder's LB92. Has the title been read?

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Kennedy then for the committee amendments to LB 92

SENATOR KENNEDY: Mr. President, fellows members there is an amendment to the committee amendment and it is passed out now and it's very simple. I can explain it if you have your books open to LB 92. I would say this came about principally of LB403 being passed and now being set up for implementation that we are going to see that all children that are educatable will be furnished transportation to the best schools possible for their education. So under this bill transportation is being provided and very simple language the bill is to give all handicapped educatable children an opportunity to have transportation and we have stricken the one part which you will see when it's passed out that limits, this would be for outstate children and the bill as it now stands as it is being operated. No person shall receive over \$400 a year that had been changed in committee in \$450, but now with the new act 403, we felt that all transportation for all children, there also was a restriction of a 4 mile limit and that's been taken off and that's the reason of this bill. But also the \$400 is stricken and the bill will read without the \$400 and the \$450. So the amendment will be identical to what you have in your book with the stricken language of the \$400 or the \$450 language out. This will give all children in the State of Nebraska the same equal opportunity which I think is a must. And if there are any questions on the committee amendment. That committee amendment that I handed in is.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy, let's clarify something here. Is this a committee amendment in lieu of the amendments here. Or is the an amendment to.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes, because it is a correction of the committee amendment. Can I offer that in lieu of the committee amendment. I asked that question up there this morning, so I do want to do this correctly.
