in out state Nebraska. I'm not sure that the school boards in the Class C Districts know about this. And Senator Carpenter may I ask you a question. You say that it is necessary that this bill be expedited and move along for some reason or other.

SENATOR CARPENTER: As I remember it, now Senator Lewis is an educator. He certainly is more knowledgeable in this field than I ever will be. And I ask for permission to let him have a discourse on what he thinks ought to be done.

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: Well, Senator Kremer we have. We passed a bill last time that said that we're going to have primary elections in certain schools, that we didn't have before. These amendments are to perfect the idea how to get that primary established and we need to move right on with it. Most of them are technical in nature, they're amendments that make it so they can be an organized legitimate method to carry out the election. In my judgement it's not new matter material. In my judgement it's simply trying to make the election an orderly process. And certainly we need to get that out as soon as we can to get the job done.

SENATOR KREMER: Well Senator Lewis, I'm sure you are right. But I was a little concerned because I've heard nothing about it. And it does affect many many schools in Nebraska. Especially when you talk under the organization program. This is why I was anxious that people knew about it and it wasn't any kind or type of feedback would get it before we voted on it.

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: What I would hope we could do, as a Legislature, I would hope that we could just move that on across and if there is concern from some of the school districts. The thing is not correct, then certainly I know Senator Carpenter would do that, and I certainly would. That we could amend it on Select File. But I think we need to process this bill out and move it as quickly as possible. And if Senator Carpenter would agree I would like to move the amendments. Get the amendments adopted and get the bill advanced today if we can.

SENATOR KREMER: I won't object. I agree with you. I just wanted to say I was a little concerned because of the lack of information that is going out because of the feedback did not come back.

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: Very good.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: The second part of these amendments. We only adopted the first section. And the Clerk can probably put that in perspective to how we can do that. And then I think between now and the time we get back, those people who have a specific interest and a desire to go further can do so on Select File with the understanding so far as I'm concerned I'll be glad to cooperate and move back to General File if that's where you want it. So if you find that any of the amendments are not to your liking, I'll attempt to assist you on Select File. I'm only the mechanic in order to attempt to get these amendments before this body. Now what procedure should we take Mr. Clerk in order to be able to adopt these amendments.
