

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion now on the second set of Carpenter amendments which were not printed. Any further question on that? The question is shall the second set of Carpenter amendments to LB592 be adopted. All those in favor of adopting those amendments please say aye, those opposed say no. Ayes have it so a ordered. The second set of amendments are adopted. Are there any further amendments on the desk to 592?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter we are ready for your motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that LB592 be moved to Select File with the understanding that if somebody wants to move it back to General File for some reasonable reason or any reason, certainly I would not object.

PRESIDENT: We can't have that as part of the motion. But that is fine, and I can understand that that is for just general information. Question is shall LB592 as amended be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Voting on the advancement of LB592 as amended. Have you all voted? Thank you the Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 Nays and 24 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced. Brings up for General File consideration LB502, by the Judiciary Committee. Has the title been read?

CLERK: Read LB502

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: There is still no fiscal note on this so we can't take it up.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the...

SENATOR LUEDTKE: We agreed that we would not take it up until we had a fiscal note. I'm not going to until we have one.

PRESIDENT: Alright, Chair concurs. Bypass 502. That brings up for General File then LB334. Senator Cavanaugh's bill.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I had that bracketed for a week.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh is asking to have 334 bracketed for a week. Are there objections to bracketing the bill? Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered. 334 is bracketed. Move on to 610, Senator Clark's bill, Senator Clark in the Chamber? Has the title been read?

CLERK: Read LB610.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature I move that 610 be advanced to E & R. The reason for this bill was a fact that government subdivisions do not now pay documentary
