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on what is done to their children. They would have no impact because they are not a part of the board of education. Yet, while they can stay out from under the board of education in Omaha, you will not consent to giving us a representative on that board. When I first came down here I was called a lot of negative things. I was called radical, militant, destructive, uncooperative and other things that were not said in my presence. I came into the Legislature I learned the rules, that are applied here. I have won victories on this floor only to have them taken from me by the Governor. I have not played games with you down here. I have not lied to you. There are members from Omaha who say they oppose these bills because of the possibility of what they call log rolling. Yet self-righteous Senator Snyder, I wish he were here. There he is. Who talks about log rolling, pulls some of this himself by introducing a bill which he said was to punish the other Senators if they voted for my bill. He is the log roller. Then after he brought in the games playing. He said these were the kind of games that are played when you have district elections. District elections do not result in game playing. Games are played by game players. Not the method of election, but the type of individual who is elected. I'm not playing a game with you here this morning. I've not played any games with you down here since I've been here. I would be gratified if you would not play any with me. That bill was frivolously introduced, as were other bills by members of the Omaha delegation. In conjunction with the Lobbyists for the Omaha Board of Education. That is showing contempt for the Legislature. That is showing contempt for this body. The Lobbyists for the Omaha Board of Education had 3 stooges, 4 really, introduce bills to punish this Legislature, and the Legislature buckled. There are parogatives of the body that must be upheld. A bill was passed relating to banking last session which I was opposed to all the way across the board and voted against it on Final Reading, but when the Governor vetoed it I felt the reason for doing so was illegitimate. That the Legislature had legitimately exercised its power. And not only did I vote for the override I spoke for the override and I believe he was overridden. There comes a time when certain basic and fundamental principles of this government must be upheld. And it is ironic that I was called so destructive has to make the plea that we hold to the rules that govern this body. In asking you to reconsider the action of not overriding the Governor. I'm going to ask you if you possibly can to forget my personality. To forget any negative vision they have of me. I happen to be the instrumentality to bring this bill before the body. It is designed to accomplish some justice where there has not been justice. As far as it is not being applicable to the rest of the districts in the state. Clearly that is the case, and I'm not going to be much longer. There was a legendary Greek robber named Procrustes, he would invite people to his liar and they fair sumptuously, that means that he fed them well. And when time came to go to bed, the put them in a bed, and if they were too long he chopped them off. If they were too short he stretched them, and he always was able to do one of the other because he had a long bed and a short bed. Now we are not a Procrustes bed in this Legislature, where we say one shoe is going to fit every foot, one hat is going to fit every head. We have to tape measure, we have the shears and we are supposed to tailor the laws we pass to fit the situations that they are designed to deal with. You cannot take a sparsely populated, widely dispersed community in rural area in Nebraska, and equate it with a densely populated like Omaha. Bills come before the Government Committee at all times dealing with County Government
