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where they base the classification on the number in that county. There is the County Attorney Bill coming before the Judiciary Committee based on this. When Omaha was dealing with the Daylight Savings time issue in the Legislature, they asked for and received consideration from this body because of the peculiar economic situations in Omaha. When Omaha wants something they come down here and ask for it. If you are going to say only those things can go to Omaha which the Omaha Senators vote for Omaha could never get anything through because it takes more than 12 votes to pass the bill. Most of the issues I've voted on down on here have not related to me or my welfare at all. But I believe fair is fair. I don't have to be a poor farmer to understand what it means to be a poor farmer. My child doesn't have to be hungry for me to know what a hungry child is. And when these kind of measures have been presented to this body I have supported them, not just with a vote, but by speaking for them to. I'm asking that you not do what Senator Snyder did on a bill that I had before this body, and that I'm just being stubborn and unreasonable. I'm not stubborn, I'm persistent. In the thing that Senator Warner is persistent on his School Aid Bill. When you believe in something you cannot abandon the principle. And that's the same with Senator Carpenter persistent on the Homestead measures and other related proposals. In the same Senator Schmit, I don't say now, but his name is becoming related and associated with drug control measures. Senator Luedtke and he's not here right now, but he will be here in time to vote, I hope, is becoming associated with Court reform. When I was pushing for Penal reform and nobody said I was doing out of malice or being stubborn. If I'm going to push for change just to improve the lot of prisoners how can I do less for children who are trying to obtain a fair education. Keep this in mind then I'll stop for now. There has been a segregation, a desegregation suit filed against the Public School of Omaha by the U.S. Justice Department. However much power you may attribute to me, I don't control the United States Government. I do not pull strings on the U.S. Justice Department, and the system as far as the educational opportunities of black and poor children are concerned in the city of Omaha. If you are really saying is that the Omaha Board of Education has the right to deny my child an education and the right to deny the representation of the board which establishes policies governing the education of my children. I ask you to vote with me. To reconsider that action in not overriding his veto.

CHAIRMAN: The chair will explain the rule. This is a motion to reconsider our action requires 25 votes. Should it get 25 or more votes then the question before us will be whether or not to override the Governor's veto. Is there any further discussion. Are you ready for the question? If you are in favor of Senator Chambers motion vote aye, if you are opposed vote no. Have you all voted?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Can I make a point of order. Can the Clerk read the names of the Senators who were excused.

SPEAKER: Do we have any objections to that.

CLERK: Senators Burbach, Johnson and Marvel are excused and absent. Senator DeCamp has not arrived.
