

SENATOR KELLY: Yes.

SENATOR BARNETT: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: I pass.....

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, I don't want to take advantage of my friend Senator Kelly, we are friendly and I would like to have the bill bracketed for....until next Monday so that we can understand the bill better than we do, including myself now. This thing is just the installment branch of a bank that has the right to take both functions. It is the same as a bank. You can call it any name you want to but as long as it is a bank in the same room in the same building. But anyway I make a motion that we lay the bill over until next Monday, unless Senator Kelly has some objection.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly do you object to laying the bill over until next Monday?

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, I certainly want to be sure that everybody in the Legislature understands this procedure and I don't know how to determine, if we do, it would be my guess that the members of the legislature do understand this bill and lets do just proceed and get rid of it.

PRESIDENT: Well, then the motion before us then if he... he is objecting to laying the bill over. Senator Carpenter I presume that your next motion would be too....Senator Kelly did I misunderstand?

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, I would agree with Senator Carpenter to lay the bill over. Lets just move right on with our business.

PRESIDENT: Fine, I interpreted your remarks as being an objection. Are there any objections to bracketing this particular bill? Excuse me, Senator Murphy do you object?

SENATOR MURPHY: Just one point of information. I think this is relative to in fact. That bill was heard in front of the miscellaneous subjects committee and I believe the banking committee and it was my understanding that the gentleman requesting this bill is in fact not associated with the bank but is a singular trust company. This is not a bank request. Secondly last year this legislature extended the time allow to finance house trailers. Now we have extended the time to finance house trailers but to do so under the present laws where a bank can finance a house trailer it could not equally finance the ground where a house trailer sits on and I don't think too many people extend mortgages on residents on real estate that they don't have an equal equity in.

PRESIDENT: Any objections to bracketing the bill until next Monday? Senator Carpenter, I wonder, the Chair wonders if you want to retract your motion to indefinitely postpone?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Yes, yes, certainly.

PRESIDENT: All right, are there objections to Senator Carpenter withdrawing his motion to indefinitely postpone 680? Hearing none, so ordered the motion to indefinitely postpone is withdrawn and the bill is bracketed until next Monday. This brings up for general file debate LB613 which is Senator Carpenters and Waldrons bill. Senator Carpenter.
