

PRESIDENT: All right, is there any further discussion of Senator Lewis' amendment to LB 490 on Select File, any further discussion of that amendment? Question is shall the amendment then be adopted? All those in favor will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. You are voting on the Lewis amendment to LB 490 on Select File which has just been unbracketed by unanimous consent. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes.

PRESIDENT: The motion is adopted are there any further amendments to the bill? All right are there other amendments to the bill? Alright, the motion is then shall the bill...Question is shall LB 490 as amended be advanced from Select File to E & R Engrossing. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye. Ayes have it so ordered. Bill is advanced. Do we have other motions on the desk?

CLERK: OK Mr. President, unanimous consent motion from Senator Carstens read.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections? Hearing none, so ordered. What else do we have on the desk?'

CLERK: Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to bracket LB 513 on a..a..for January 30.

PRESIDENT: 513 for January 30th.

CLERK: Oh on Final REading Mr. President, it has got to be set for the 28th.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Are there objections to bracketing 513 on Final Reading until the 30th? Any objections? Hearing none so ordered then. The bill is bracketed until the 30th.

CLERK: Now Mr. President, Senator Syas did yesterday on page 380 of the Journal move to withdraw LB 900.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: I move that the motion be complied with and we get these bills out of the way and if something develops later, which we can come to...there are other avenues for settling this thing, and I think that all this session, this thing has been well debated and I think now that this is for class six school districts, that is school districts with the high schools only. Not grade schools, and I think that the bill should be withdrawn.
