SENATOR BARNETT: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the Chair be overruled.

SENATOR SYAS: Wait a minute, wait a minute, wait a minute.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas, go ahead.

SENATOR SYAS: I am not so sure, maybe if this looses, can I come back with another motion? Now I will tell you what the motion is right now, it is to suspend the rules. Then I am going to put you guys....

PRESIDENT: That is fine, that is fine. The question is, shall the Chair be overruled? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 3 ayes, 31 nays Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Syas, your motion has lost to overrule the Chair, now make your next motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that we recess until 1:30 signed Senator Carpenter. Oh excuse me, I thought you wanted to take it up.

PRESIDENT: We got it, now Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: I want to make a motion here to suspend the rules but the motioning to 1:30, we have committee hearings this afternoon.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Let's not argue about it.

SENATOR SYAS: I move that we suspend the rules and LB900 be withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: O.K. now, do you want to debate that issue? The question is, shall the rules be suspended and Senator Syas be allowed to withdraw LB900, all those in favor of that motion will vote aye, all those opposed will vote no. The motion is to suspend the rules and allow Senator Syas to withdraw LB900. Have you all voted? Alright Senator Syas asking for a Call of the House. Clerk will clear the board. At the next bell, please indicate your support of a Call of the House. This is a motion for a Call of the House only. Have you all voted? Thank you, the Clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 10 nays Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, we are now under a Call of the House, and the Chair would respectfully ask the Senators to take their seats. The Sergeant of Arms will round up any in the rotunda and bring them in and put them in their seats please. We are under a Call of the House gentlemen, the question is under vote, and lady, the question under vote, shall the rules be suspended and Senator Syas be allowed to withdraw LB900. Senator Snyder, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR SNYDER: A record vote.

PRESIDENT: You want a record vote. Alright, Senator Snyder asking for a record vote. Alright, the motion under vote is a suspension of the rules for a withdrawal of LB900. Senator Syas?

SENATOR SYAS: I made a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: I should ask them to indicate their presence. Please indicate your presence? Senator Warner, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR WARNER: Just a point of clarification.

PRESIDENT: Yes.
