PRESIDENT: I move for the consideration for the bills on
Select File. Fine, let's take up Senator Cavanaugh, LB359
first on Select File. Stand by.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the E & R Amendments to LB 359.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the E & R Amendments
to 359 on Select File. Will all those in favor of that
motion please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered.
The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that LB 359 as
amended by advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion now to advance the
bill as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill
please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. The bill
as amended is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of
E & R Amendments to LB 592.

CLERK: There are no E & R Amendments to 599, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: No E & R Amendments to 599.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: 592

PRESIDENT: Yes, we have a series of amendments, Senator
Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: You want to leave 592.

PRESIDENT: Yes, we want to leave 592 for a moment. Go to
599.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: All right, I move that 599 be advanced
to E & R for Engrossing.
