SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of that?
Senator Moylan.

SENATOR MOYLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature.
A question to Senator Whitney, please.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Yield.

SENATOR MOYLAN: I have a bill in retirement LB 786. I see
this morning it had been set for hearing on March 6th. I
don't know if they are trying to put that out of reach or
what they are trying to do with it, but that seems a late
date for a hearing.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President. The retirement committee
is a separate committee from any of the other standing
committees. And we are having to meet at noons. Run through
the noon hour with our committee hearings, because we do
not have time set for the other meetings. And we have
attempted to set as many meetings as possible to satisfy
the members of the committee so that they would be there.
And that's the reason for that being set at that time.

SENATOR MOYLAN: Well, I did think that maybe that was your
trouble, because I know you don't have a special hearing
time. But I did want to ask the question as long as it came
up here this morning. Thank you.

SPEAKER: Is there other discussion. If not is there any
thing further on the Clerk's desk?

CLERK: Mr. President your committee on Education to whom
LB 772 instructs me to report the same legislation recommend
to be advanced to General File as amended. (Signed) Senator
Warner.

SPEAKER: Are we now ready for General File, Mr. Clerk?
LB 986. I see that's the Governor's bill introduced by
Proud. Senator Marvel. Yes Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: Legislative Bill 986 (read)

SPEAKER: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is in order that the bill be
advanced to Initial. And this is simply the regular bill
that's introduced each time to take care of the salaries
of offices in Nebraska State Government.

SPEAKER: Now is there any further discussion? I repeat
the question. All those in favor of advancing vote aye,
those opposed vote no. Have you all voted. The Clerk will
record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, no nays, remainder not voting.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. LB 987. Another Governor's
bill. The Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: LB 987 (read)
