SPEAKER: Ready for the question? The question is shall the committee amendments be adopted? All those in favor say aye. Those opposed no. Committee amendments stand adopted. Now are there further amendments Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, there are a series of additional amendments. The next one in order I suppose would be Senator Simpson's, unless Senator..

SPEAKER: I believe that the principal introducer has the right to take up his amendments if he desires.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Are these the list of 7 amendments that

CLERK: These are the amendments that are set out in the Journal on page 350.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Yes, now these..all of these amendments are incorporated later in the amendments that Senator Goodrich has up there, except the 1st one which I think is a separate amendment that was brought to me by the Court Administrator and it strikes the "District Court" the court you go into as a suit, because any appeal then again would go to the District Court, so it strikes "District" and makes this the "County Court" where they would take their suit. So I would ask unanimous consent to withdraw all the amendments except Number 1.

SPEAKER: All right, Senator Simpson is asking unanimous

consent to withdraw all his amendments, which are printed in the Journal. Are they Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: Where bouts?

CLERK: Page 350.

SPEAKER: Page 350. Except the withdrawal of the No. 1 amendment. Is that so listed as No. 1. So we know what we are talking about.

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: All right. Is there any objection to him withdrawing all his amendments, that's Senator Simpson's amendments, except the first amendment. Do I hear any objection to that. I want to give you time to look at these. This is an important bill. Senator Goodrich do you have any objections?

SENATOR GOODRICH: No, just a question of Senator.. Is Luedtke in the room? O. K. Senator Simpson perhaps you can answer the question and I notice you are switching from "district County" and inserting "county". Is this going to be any problem with the way we restructure the County Courts last term in 1042 I believe it was.
