SPEAKER: If they are not in the Journal. Where are they?

CLERK: Just on the bill.

SPEAKER: You know which amendments he's talking about. You have them in front of you. All right, all those in favor of adopting these Goodrich Amendments say aye. Those opposed no. The amendments are adopted. Now are there any further amendments?

CLERK: Yes. Now Mr. President we have an amendment offered by Senator Mahoney. Which would be on page 12, line 11 (read)

SPEAKER: Do you want to take that up, Senator Mahoney? I don't know whether you have been here all the time. We have adopted various committee amendments, Senator Goodrich amendments and one thing and another. Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, this amendment was left over from last year, and the Omaha Housing Authority asked that in these particular amendments that they be exempt from them.

SPEAKER: Any discussion of that? Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Senator Mahoney yield? Does this mean Senator that the..all public housing is exempt from all the provisions of this new law?

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. Clerk would you read that portion again? Read that portion.

CLERK: Read the whole amendment? Amendment read by Clerk.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Then Senator Mahoney does that reference to a section referred to..

SENATOR MAHONEY: Federal Housing.

SENATOR FELLMAN: All Federal Housing.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Federal Housing, that is correct.

SENATOR FELLMAN: And what..it says a certain section is eliminated. What is that?

SENATOR MAHONEY: Senator Fellman, you'd have to...I'll have to put it over because I'll have to go do the research. I'm caught without the information and I'll just have to ask that it be placed over and go back to the Omaha Housing Authority Attorney and get the information because it was a bill in the last days of the last session.

SPEAKER: Oh, you're not asking Senator Mahoney that the bill be held. You will reserve your amendments for Select File or what.

SENATOR MAHONEY: No, I think that you could hold it. I don't think we are in that big of a rush on the bill.

SPEAKER: It's all right with the Chair. Are you asking then that the bill be held over. Senator Goodrich.
