a Fiscal note from the Governor's staff. Are there objections to Bracketing the bill until that time. Hearing none. So ordered. The bill is Bracketed. That moves us to General File consideration then of Senator Cavanaugh's LB 334.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Cavanaugh requests to lay over the bill.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to laying over LB 334. Hearing none. So ordered. Pass over 334. Ready then for Senator Goodrich's 653. Wait just a minute. Yes, 653.

CLERK: Mr. President, the bill was previously read on January 22. There are no committee amendments. There is an amendment printed in the Journal from Senator Goodrich on page 447. 447 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich what is your pleasure regarding 653?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Can we take up another bill and come back to this one, whatever the next bill is. Senator Cavanaugh and I are conferring on an amendment here.

PRESIDENT: That would bring up then 626, Senator Barnett's bill. Senator Barnett what is your pleasure..just stand by we will see what the condition is here. The bill.

Mr. President there is a committee amendment from the Banking Committee signed by Senator Carstens. Fred Carstens.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Fred Carstens in the Chamber? For the amendment on Senator Barnett's 626. Senator Barnett he's on the phone. Do you want to handle the amendment, the committee amendment. The Chair recognizes Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. Chairman I move for the adoption of the amendment. The amendment on this 626, the bill was brought in by Bill Brandt with the Banking. And they ask in the Industrial Loan Association, they had the same error the same mistake that was made in a bill that we passed last year. And this is basically corrective language to correct the mistake that was made last year, so I move the adoption, and Senator Carstens is here to either to agree or disagree with my definition of it.

SENATOR CARSTENS: The statement made by Senator Barnett is correct and I move the adoption of the amendment. It was unanimously approved by the committee.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the committee amendments. All those in favor of adopting the committee amendments please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. The committee amendment is adopted.

CLERK: There are no other amendments, Mr. President.
