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extensions from time to time.

SENATOR MOYLAN: I don't believe that it covers extensions.

SENATOR WHITNEY: OK, thank you.

SENATOR MOYLAN: It is to fill in gaps, and streets. This is the main purpose of this bill.

SPEAKER: Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President, members of the body, I talked to the city officials when we had our meeting with them concerning all of their bills and I remember this item and it is clearly my understanding that this is the a...a.. to fill gaps only. The real purpose of the bill is that if you leave it the way it is, it says two blocks. But, if you don't have the intersection and in fact the land area is does not go up to the 1,300 feet, they can't close in what otherwise would be two blocks. This is a little difficult to understand. In other words if you have intersections and the blocks are clearly laid out, then you can do it, but if it is just one tract with no intersection in the middle then it used to revert to the old 12-50 feet. But unfortunately the way miles are laid out, even though the intent would be when it is fully developed to be two blocks, it takes 1350 to really utilize this two block definition. So it is strictly to close a gap. Not to make extensions and it is to allow for the measurement of a mile when this 1200 feet just doesn't work in with the measurement of the mile.

SPEAKER: I believe that Senator Nore has the answer to all of this.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. President, members. Ever village, city, and town is on the outer edges of a town is backed up to a farm land. There is a problem sometimes where you probably have an 80, one side of the road is the city and the other side is the farm. Now is this fellow who owns the farm going to be rocked to sleep every two years with two more blocks of paving? Can someone answer that for me?

: Mr. President, members Senator Stahmer just went into that explanation a minute ago, that this is used for filling in gaps in streets. That is the absolute purpose and Senator Stahmer visited with the city officials and since I have and quized them on it. It is the purpose of this bill to fill in a gap where there is a gap in the city streets. Does that answer your question Senator Nore?

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? Senator Nore you have your light on. Thank you. Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: May I ask Senator Moylan another question? Does this only pertain to first class cities? That is the 18th Chapter of the book?

SENATOR MOYLAN: The bill reads, any city or village. The bill itself does. I believe that is evidentially in the statute, I think. That is not new material.

SENATOR WHITNEY: I thought that Chapter 18, pertained to only first class cities and that is why I am asking the question.

SENATOR MOYLAN: Well I didn't check the statutes on it and this is 18, 20-01 but the bill reads and evidentially this is
