

PRESIDENT: OK, go ahead Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: I have a question. Is this bill to build side walks or streets?

SENATOR SYAS: Streets.

SENATOR DE CAMP: And you have your children walk on streets? We use sidewalks out in my county.

SENATOR SYAS: Unfortunately we don't always have by these schools even sidewalks.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President, members of the body, lets try to go back to English once again and see what the bill says. I agree with Senator Syas 100%. As matters now stand if you have 2 blocks those two blocks could even be 1,500 feet long but because you have an intersection you can go in and pave that a gap. But when you don't have the intersection then you have to revert to the footage and in the reason they need the 1350 is because of a quarter of a mile. It just things get loused up because streets are laid out on these mile lines. In fact, gaps could be closed now that are greater than 1200 feet if they are at intersections and you have some blocks laid out that are 700 feet. Then you could pave 1,400 feet. This isn't going to do anything close to what Senator DeCamp is worried about. It just try it is just trying to straighten up the measurement of a mile.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the bill? Senator Carpenter has actually moved the previous question. Lets see if we can clear this this way. Does the Chair see five hands? Thank you. Question is shall the debate now close. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are voting on the motion to close the debate on LB652. Senator Moylans bill. Thank you the Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to close debate.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the debate will now close. Senator Moylan do you have closing on your bill? Senator Moylan is now closing.

SENATOR MOYLAN: No closing, I request to advance the bill to E & R for Initial.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Motion now is to advance LB652. All those in favor of advancing the bill from General File to E & R Initial will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Motion is to advance LB652 from General File to E & R Initial. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, and the remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced. This brings up then...Senator DeCamp, did you want to be recognized for some purpose? Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp.
