PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB490. All those in favor of the motion please say aye, those opposed say no? So ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: And that LB490 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion now to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no? So ordered, the bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Now I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB699.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to adopt, I didn't hear you Senator Cavanaugh, were those amendments?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Amendments to 699.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. All those in favor of adopting the amendments to LB699 say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the E & R amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move that LB699 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Now you have heard the motion to advance 699 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill is amended as advanced. Thank you. Any other motions on the desk?

CLERK: None, Mr. President. (Read Standing Committee Reports - refer to page 474 Journal.) Motion on the desk, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: I move to suspend the rules and introduce the two new bills, signed Senator Whitney.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Whitney?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, I think that we owe it as a courtesy to Senator Luedtke, he had to be gone today, he did not ask me to do this I am doing it on my own, to introduce these two request bills, 1551 and 1529 as I understand one of them was a request by the Governor of Senator Luedtke, and it pertains to helping correcting people who have been put in prison, and several of us made a trip to the state of Iowa to see how they are doing it and I feel that this is something that has come about probably as a result of our, partly as a result of our trip to Iowa whereby, we studied the correctional system there, and I move to suspend the rules that we introduce these two bills.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? Senator Stahmer, is there any other further discussion of the motion to introduce the bills? If not, then the question is, shall the rules be suspended and the two bills introduced at once? All those in favor of doing that will vote aye, all those opposed will vote no. This is a motion for the suspension of the rules and the introduction of two new bills that Senator Luedtke had yesterday. Have you all voted? Once again, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes Mr. President on a motion to suspend the rules.

PRESIDENT: Very good. Bills will be introduced and the Clerk will read the titles please?
