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body. And that's the way it ought to be, and that's what I'm trying to make it. Let's try it on for size. Everything anybody says here is political, that's the way it ought to be. Let's make some issues here, and old age is one of them. And I'll go on television later on, I'm pretty affective and there is no rebuttle to what I say, unless you want to pay for it. And I'm making arecord now. So you understand to blow up this State. In the area in which I believe in, I'm trying to carry to the people. It's that simple. I'm not trying to prove anybody this is one of them. Now hold it on Select File if you will, I'll introduce another bill, if you permit it. Do only that, when it catches up with it then take this amendment off Senator Clark's bill and let it stand on it's own merit. I will guarantee to do that if that is the desire of this body.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis, we have under debate..then Senator Moyland, we have under the detate the motion to place Senator Mahoney his name on the bill as an introducer.

SENATOR DUIS: I merely wanted to remark to Senator Carpenter. I thank him very much for his generosity in the introduction of this other bill. I think that is what we suggested and

Is Duke taking this on his own, or what I'd like to know what your thoughts might be on this. I think it would help us.
