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in the country in these mini busses and pick these people up, and we charge what the people can afford to pay. That's the reason we don't want a regulation stating that it has to be 35¢, 15¢ or \$2.00 or whatever it's going to be. We charge now the city and the county operates these busses and for that reason we don't want a regulation. Does that explain it to you Senator Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: Yes, I think it does. In other words as I understand what you said. This just pertains to these mini busses in this particular situation. Is that correct?

SENATOR MOYLAN: Yes, sir.

SENATOR PROUD: O.K.that's correct. Well what are we talking about the Omaha Public Transportation System for?

SENATOR MOYLAN: Well, let me explain just a little further here on the Carpenter amendment as it stands at the present time. It does not affect your Omaha Transit System under any conditions now. Even with his amendment. It does not affect your Omaha system.

SENATOR PROUD: Well, then.

SENATOR MOYLAN: If you will read the amendment it says any governmental

subdivision shall provide such transportation at a cost not to exceed 10¢ per person. Which means that every public subdivision would have to set up this same type of thing for 10¢. He's regulating the cost of this as this amendment goes.

SENATOR PROUD: The bill now in no way applies to the Omaha Transit.

SENATOR MOYLAN: No, except it says you shall provide this type transportation. A new system.

SENATOR PROUD: Oh, well it pertains then to a completely new system, and it would give the elderly people no relief at all, in the public transportation system. Is that your understanding?

SENATOR MOYLAN: I don't think Senator Carpenter had this in mind, but that to me is what it does.

SENATOR PROUD: In other words, all this talk about helping the elderly on the Public Transportation System in Omaha is a bunch of garbage.

SENATOR MOYLAN: No, that's not ture.

SENATOR PROUD: Well, what is true.

SENATOR MOYLAN: It says here that you shall set up a system like this.
