CLERK: 15 ayes, 10 nays for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: We're under Call of the House. Next bill please indicate your presence. I'm sorry Senator Kelly, you'll have to standby, I've got my hands full up here. We're under a Call of the House, Senators please take your seats. We're asking you to indicate your presence. Senator Waldron asked for a Call of the House. Motion under vote is the suspension of the rules and the introduction of a bill. Senator Cavanaugh voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Cavanaugh voting aye on your original motion.

PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney take your seat please, we're under Call of the House. Senator Kelly, excuse me, Senator Murphy voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Murphy voting aye on your original motion.

PRESIDENT: We have too many Irishmen back there in that corner. Have you all indicated your presence. We're under a Call of the House. Motion under vote, listen carefully please, the motion under vote is to suspension of the rules for the introduction of a bill, offered by Senator Waldron Committee. Senator Rasmussen voting aye... Senator Richendifer voting aye... from nay to aye... Senator Maresh voting aye... Senator Goodrich voting no... Senator Clark voting no... Senator Rasmussen take your seat we're under a Call of the House... Senator Nore, we're under a Call of the House, take your seat please. Standby, Senator Nore is going to take his seat. Senator Nore how do you vote on the original issue, suspension of the rules on introduction of the bill? Voting no? Senator Nore, voting no... Senator Carstens voting aye. Alright, motion is to raise the Call. All those in favor of raising the Call vote aye, all those opposed, vote no. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 38 ayes to raise the call.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised, Senator Keyes, you're excused. Read the tally of the original vote now.

CLERK: 31 ayes to suspend the rules and introduce the bill.

PRESIDENT: That was an interesting skirmish. OK, the rules

are suspended, the bill is introduced. The Clerk will read the title please. Senator Kelly, just a moment.

CLERK: Legislative Bill 1016 introduced by the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee signed by Senators Carpenter, Cavanaugh, Mahoney, Murphy and Waldron. A bill for an act to amend section 75-104, relating to the Public Service Commission; to raise the salary of members of the Public Service Commission; and to repeal the original section.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly, I see you, but you can't stop progress. Go ahead sir.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, I just want to respectfully call to the attention of this body that the previous bill introduced was by an Irishman, but it was Murphy, and it was not Kelly. K-E-L-L-Y spells Kelly, thank you.
