Burbach's bill and there was, I believe, an amendment pending at that time. Would the Clerk bring us up to date?

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a request to bracket LB293 until February 12, signed Senator Stahmer.

PRESIDENT: 941, where did you get the motion here on 293? Things are tough enough here.

CLERK: Yes sir Mr. President 941.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, that was very diplomatic.

CLERK: Was read on February 1, and an amendment offered by Senator Burbach is pending, another amendment by Senator Burbach is pending, amendments by Senator Stull are offered. The amendment by Senator Burbach appear on page 482 and 483 of the journal.

PRESIDENT: Give the Chair a little assistance here, did you say that they were, the amendments by Senator Burbach had been adopted?

CLERK: No they are pending.

PRESIDENT: Are the Stull amendments to the Burbach amendments?

CLERK: No I don't think so. There are pending two, I guess the Burbach amendment is really one amendment, I have two copies that look different, but it is on page 3, line 5, and page 4, line 6, strike "director of state engineering" and insert "department or county authority".

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach?

SENATOR BURBACH: Does it say strike the highway department and will we have the counties do it? That isn't right then. No, I want them both. The highway department for state highways and counties for the county roads, is that written wrong?

CLERK: The bill presently reads as the director of the state engineer determines and that is what you asked to strike and insert department or county authority.

SENATOR BURBACH: Would you by pass this one, can we do this and take Senator Stull's amendment and I will see what is wrong and I will come up there and check it?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Stull's amendment is on page 3, line 5, strike "November 1 to April 1" and insert "December 1 to March 15". On page 6 in lines 13, 14, and 15 strike the new matter. Signed Senator Stull.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stull?

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I think that we should consider this amendment in two parts, and the first part simply shortens the time that these permits can be used, and it strikes from November 1 till April 1 and it would be from the first of December to March 15, and I think that is a period when we have our frost in the ground. I move the adoption of the amendments.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion of the Stull amendment now to 941? Question is, shall the Stull amendment then be adopted, all those in favor please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, Stull amendment is adopted. 1-0.
