

and die artifacts. We have laws on our books to prevent this but if the area is not marked, then they can always say well we didn't know it way so this merely asks the county boards to mark those cemeteries that are unknown. I move the adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Any discussion? Question has been called for, we will take a voice vote, those in favor say aye, those opposed no. The motion carries, the amendment is adopted.

CLERK: There are no further amendments.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Senator Carsten ?

SENATOR CAL CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move LB608 be advanced to E & P. Now Mr. President the purpose of this bill was this was a bill that we had 277 last year giving or requesting the county boards to keep the cemeteries up, but we did learn that later that some of the veterans organizations have been doing some work and some of the leral minds that were associated with the veterans association felt that they were restricted that it was only left to the county boards and they had asked that we make this only permissive so that the veterans organizations could continue their work and we are wholeheartedly in support of it, we don't want these cemeteries neglected and with their help, they can be restored and kent in shape and that is the reason for the bill.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Any discussion of the bill? If there is no discussion, those in favor of LB608 vote aye, those opposed vote nay. Senator Whitney voting aye.
