I do think that the rest of it such as Senator Barnett suggests is a good feature of this bill, that the court may sentence such person to complete such rehabilitatory tasks as the court shall deem appropriate and then enumerate them. But, I would move Mr. President that we amend the amendment by striking the line in lieu of the fine the court (read) Those three sentences.

PRESIDENT: Those three lines?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Those three lines because they are already part of the law and unnecessary.

PRESIDENT: Probably more than three lines, probably three sentences then. Is there discussion of that? Senator Chambers do you want to discuss Senator Luedtke's amendment here? You don't want to discuss Senator Luedtke's you want to discuss another section of the bill? Thank you. Senator Barnett do you want to respond to Senator Luedtke's amendment.

SENATOR BARNETT: If it meets with the body's approval I have no objection to striking that. I just...that was put in there following the bill that we adopted last year and we tried to make a penalty section just as we did last year.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh, did you want to speak on Senator Luedtke's amendment here?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I suggest that he add in the next to delete work there. The court may in lieu of fine or work penalties, strike that work there.

PRESIDENT: Alright, fine, that is included in the motion. Do you all understand the motion? All those in favor of Senator Luedtke's motion which would amend the Barnett amendment to 827, please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered then, the amendment is adopted. Then we come back...Senator Chambers it has been amended and I think that you were next to speak. Do you want to direct a question to Senator Barnett?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I want to know when it will be appropriate to speak on the bill and I guess that will be done after he speaks with reference to his amendment?

PRESIDENT: Right, let's get the amendment then we will go on to the bill. Now, Senator Barnett we are back to you then, only on the amendment as amended.

SENATOR BARNETT: The only thing that I was concerned with was this whole bill, was the bill was going to pass, if passed that it would have a decent penalty section where the kids wouldn't be effected and now, I have got the penalty section that I think is best if this bill passes, therefore I move that we advance...

PRESIDENT: No, we have to adopt....

SENATOR BARNETT: I thought that we did, because Senator Luedtke amended that.

PRESIDENT: No, because Senator LUedtke amended that.
