PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Stahmer for his motion.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President and members of the body, I'll try to be very brief. I was invited to the Governor's Mansion along with some other Senators about two weeks ago and I always accept these invitations whether they be to Westside High to speak to students or where ever, and at this meeting, right at the end of the meeting the Governor said now one other thing I want to talk to you gentlemen about, he said for Gods Sake, No he didn't say that, pardon me. He said for Goodness Sake, don't allow this land that's now used as parking to be converted to some other use. There's a paraphrase rather a madhouse parking situation around here right now and this is the last place we need to be attracting more people and I said, to paraphrase again, Governor where were you when I needed you. You know you could have got this message over here sooner, but I really am not all that certain about this, but I think this bill needs more discussion. I didn't even think about any parking problems when we were first discussing it. And if indeed, we are going to create more of a problem, plus the fact that the Governor said that we're going to wipe out this other square block we have for parking over at the new state office building. And as most of you know, I think I'm as neutral in here politically as anyone, I'm not the Governor's errand boy, but since I raised the issue once before, I'm willing to raise it again. I think we ought to take another look at this and if everyone disagrees, so be it.
