PRESIDENT: The motion is lost to bracket the bill. Are there any other motions now on LB 704. Clerk will clear the board. Once again, gentlemen I would remind you that we are on Final Reading that would require you to be in your seats if you don't mind. Clerk will read LB 704

CLERK: LB 704 read.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, "Shall the bill pass?" All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Once again, the question is, have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Voting aye 39, voting nay 7 3 not voting.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. This particular legislation was brought about because of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, Article 4, Section 16 if you would care to look it up. What it says at the present time is that every bill, every order, every resolution, and vote, except a vote for adjournment shall be presented to the Governor. Now we sincerely believe in the Rules Committee that no one desired to have every resolution, every vote, and every order, and we don't even know what they mean by order in the Constitution be presented to the Governor. Now we are asking for introduction of this bill so that it might be placed on the primary election ballot. So we would like to get it introduced now because we must have it passed before February 28th, so it can get on the ballot. So I would ask for the introduction of the bill.
