PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion of the motion. Any further discussion of Senator Duis' motion? Then the question is, Shall the bill be introduced. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. This is the motion to introduce the bill. Constitution amendment signed by Senator Duis. The Senator's motion does require 30 votes. Senator Duis' motion is to introduce the bill. All right, Senator Duis what is your pleasure?

SENATOR DUIS: I'm going to talk here for just a moment until we get more buttons up here so I don't have to have a call of the House. In this request, we will also request of the Reference Committee if I might, that the Reference Committee put this bill on General File instead of having it sent to Committee and put it ahead of General File because it is necessary that it pass by February 28th. If we do not get this on the ballot and get it passed by the people of the State of Nebraska we are going to have a lot of messages going back and forth here that are absolutely unnecessary. And if I can just get 5 more votes here without Calling the House, why we will be ready to go.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I would withdraw a Call of the House.

CLERK: Cal Carstens voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Now the question is, shall the Call be withdrawn. All those in favor of raising the call then vote aye, those opposed vote no. This motion is to raise the Call of the House. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes to Raise the Call.
