

in putting in the insured needs was to make sure that the level of support reached that as in terms of per pupil expenditure and then of course the equalization fund came by deductible limit of the qualifying levy. So really to equalize what you wanted to do and put everybody on the same standard the insured needs have to be at a level enough to support a minimum quality program. That is what you are going to have to do to put more money into equalization. Mr. President, I just rise to support the 50-50 and the question procedure there and to point out that certainly the bill can be so arranged as to put 50-50 into equalization and I had that amendment prepared and I will have it on the desk to offer it so that we can put 50% into the equalization.

PRESIDENT: At the present time we are still discussing the Carpenter amendment. Is there anybody else that wants to be heard on the Carpenter amendment? Then, however, we are going to have to have some clarification here. Senator Maresh you apparently have some amendments up here and it looks like those amendments relate to the Carpenter amendment. Is that correct?

SENATOR MARESH: Right.

PRESIDENT: Alright, lets proceed on those then, if there is no more discussion on the Carpenter amendment, lets see if we can get it amended and move it on here.

CLERK: Read Maresh amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR DUIS: I believe that Senator Maresh is in the wrong part of this amendment. I think that he is trying to get into the limitation and spending part of it which isn't before us yet.
