

PRESIDENT: Very good, that helps. Alright then we actually still have before the Carpenter amendment as found on page 507, 8 and 9 of the Journal. That is the only motion and amendment under consideration at this time. The question is shall that amendment then be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. We are only voting on the amendment found on a page 507 of the Journal. The Carpenter amendment to LB772 on Select File to adopt that particular amendment it takes 25 votes. SENATOR CARPENTER: A roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter is asking for a roll call vote.

CLERK: 23 ayes for a call of the house.

PRESIDENT: We are under a call of the house. Please take your seats gentlemen. AT the next bell, please indicate your presence. We are asking you to indicate your presence and we are under a call of the house. The motion on or under vote is Senator Carpenter's amendment to LB772 on Select File as found on page 507 of the Legislative Journal. We are asking you to indicate your presence. We are under a call of the house. The motion under vote is the Carpenter amendment to LB772, on Select File and the amendment is found on page 507 of the Journal. We are going to have a roll call vote. As soon as we ask everybody to indicate their presence. Senator Carpenter.
