and followed the expenditures. The other point I would make and it has already been made is that this is the only body that the constitutionally has the right to appropriate money. All these boards that come in and ask us for money are free as far as pressure is concerned, because the pressure is on us. We had a debate here a couple years ago as to whether we could simply lump sum appropriations, and I think we rather specifically pointed out tha the Constitution indicates that we are the final authority and no other division of government Now I'd like to go on and

PRESIDENT: Stand by, Senator Marvel. Senator Nore do you have a question abotu this area.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. Chairman, I'd like to ask Senator Marvel a question, f he would yield.

PRESIDENT: He yields.

SENATOR MARVEL: I always yield to you Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: Yes, fine, thank you. We have had in the past years some criticism of the testing of water and sometimes that I feel that it probably isn't too accurate. The credibility isn't good. I think there was one ..well there was a situation where they took a dozen out of the same stream and sent them in and about half of them passed and half didn't. Now just how credible are these tests. Will this \$90,200 tighten this up just a little bit.

SENATOR MARVEL: My understanding of what the \$90,200 does in the wording on page 15 is to provide additional muscle for this department to examine municipal water supplies in the area of floridation, but also in the general of area of examination It appears to me that this would do what you have just indicated and what you are interested in.

SENATOR NORE: Fine. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Frank...Senator Frank Lewis you light is still on would you, thank you. Maybe you can still turn that off..I won't have difficulty of who wants to speak. Senator Nore turn your light off too, would you please. Thank you.

SENATOR MARVEL: All right, the page 16, we are talking about State Fire Marshall's office which is a continuation budget basically. You will note wording line 20 to 22 which transfers the fire service and safety program to the State Board of Technical Community Colleges. Page 17 is a continuation budget for the Department of Insurance. Page 18 has to do with the Department of Labor, which includes two additional, actually three additional inspectors. The bottom of page 18 is the Department of Motor Vehicles, which is a continuation plus additional personnel to implement the driver's license computerization program, which they have been working on for some time. Page 20 is the Department of Veterans Affairs, which includes a continuation plus three additional people to work on the job training area, and there is a specific language which tied to this department and line 3 through 9 which have to do with
